


Mid Norfolk Conservation Volunteers

Date	Site	Activity	Where to meet us on site (if travelling independently) at 10.00am
Friday 1 st November	Scarning Water Meadows	The Rake's Progress part 2 – continuing to remove the cut vegetation on Lucy's Meadow – and possibly trimming a bramble hedge.	Park: Junction of Chestnut Road and Allwood Avenue, Scarning, Dereham, Norfolk, by the entrance to Ted Ellis Walk – look for the Scarning PC notice board. Nearest post code NR19 2TF. (TF 98277 13123). Meet at Lucy's Meadow: Follow Ted Ellis walk around to the left towards the town centre; Lucy's Meadow is on your right. BRING WELLIES
Friday 8 th November	Litcham Common 	Common ground? General conservation work on this County Wildlife Site in the Nar Valley.	Main car park, Litcham Common, Dunham Road, Litcham. Friday 15 th November	NWT Foxley Wood	Slash and Burn! Clearing up brushings or coppicing, whatever takes your fancy.	Foxley Wood nature reserve – 1 st (most northerly) car park after public entrance, Themelthorpe Road, Foxley, NR20 4QR (TG 049 229). Those who wish can take vehicles on site, closer to where we are working.
Friday 22 nd November	Mayfields Farm	The Last Post? Continuing our work in the orchard (and possibly removing tree guards in readiness for hedge cutting)	Mayfields Farm car park, Reepham Road (between Peddlars Turnpike and Kerdiston Road), Foulsham, NR20 5PS (TG 053 245). WC. BRING WELLIES
Friday 29 th November	Gressenhall Museum	Hedge laying for beginners or building log piles in the wood.	Park: Main car park at Gressenhall Farm and Workhouse, Gressenhall, Dereham, NR20 4DR. (TF 975 170). Ignore 'Museum Closed' sign! Meet: MNCV tool shed – go through gate at R of main building marked 'Staff Only', thru 2 nd gate and shed is on the L. WC
