Audio Play and Sing-a-long Resource

We've listed a few tips and ideas to help you to get the best out of this resource:

1. To listen to the audio play via the website link you will need good internet signal. There are three episodes each 30 minutes long so you may want to make an event of it and listen to one episode at a time then do a couple of songs or you might want to split the play and the songs to different events.
2. If you do not have strong internet we can provide the play on a CD, this can be played on computer (with speakers), laptop and CD players.
3. To watch the sing-a-long film you will need good internet signal. If this may be an issue please let us know as we can provide you with the film on DVD instead.
4. Print the song sheets in advance, we have formatted these to be in large print but kept it as a word document so this can be increased if required.
5. The film can be watched on a computer, laptop or tablet or by connecting a device with internet to a larger screen or TV.
6. Consider using additional or separate speakers for better quality sound if listening on a computer or laptop.
7. Test any tech including sound levels before running this as an activity for residents.
8. If you choose to and you can do so whilst adhering to social distancing, you might want to make a month of it and bring residents together to listen to one episode of the play per week at the same time and finish with the sing a long film.
9. You could use the episodes and sing a long film as a way for residents to connect with families and friends outside the home. Let them know what time you will be watching, invite them to do so too, and to share their experiences afterwards.
10. It makes a big difference when staff are present during the session and they help and encourage residents to sing along.
