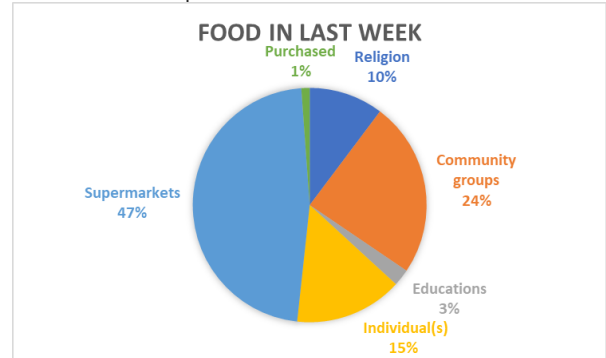

Tinned tomatoes, pasta sauce, cereal (not greater than 500g), tinned fish (tuna, mackerel, sardines, salmon), tinned fruit in juice (not prunes or grapefruit); crisps; rice (500g), toilet roll, strong carrier bags

Tinned potatoes, tinned spaghetti, squash, long-life fruit juice, UHT semi-skimmed milk, dog/cat food, instant hot-chocolate (not cocoa powder), instant coffee (not decaffeinated), porridge (not greater than 500g), ready-made custard (tinned/carton); UHT whole milk, tinned rice pudding, tinned meat (ham, corned beef, pork sandwich, pulled pork, chicken), teabags (40's or 80's), jam/honey, biscuits, chocolate and snack bars, liquid/bar soap, laundry power/liquid (not family sized), gender neutral shower-gel, gender neutral shampoo, sugar (500g), toothpaste, single or duo wrapped toothbrushes
