Distribution of food Clients or their representatives will need to collect the parcels from B30Foodbank, Quaker Friends Meeting House 23aWatford Road B30 1JB on Tuesday and Friday between 1.30 and 3.30pm.

Last week we received in donations 1459kgs and gave out 1762k, 1260k to 94 clients on 54 vouchers, nd 552k to other foodbanks or similar. 34% came from Street Collections Featherstone Rd Highbury Rd, Northfield Road 2 Selly Park, Station Rd Third Avenue, Tudor Rd for which we are very grateful In MAY we received in in donations 6466k and gave out 6919k, 5771k to 464 clients on 238 vouchers 1148k to other foodbanks or similar

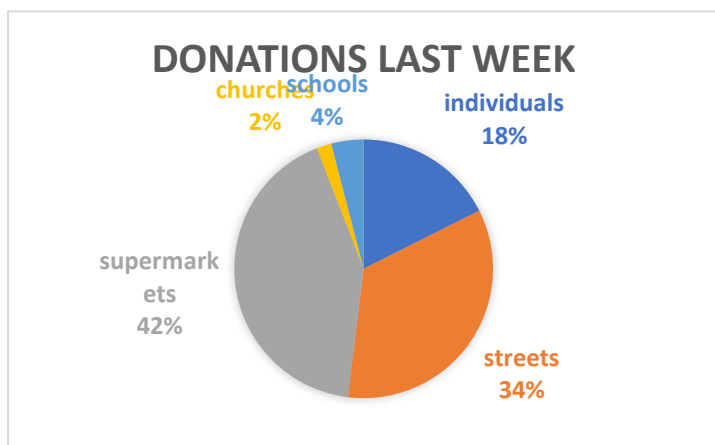
Tinned meat (ham, corned beef, pork sandwich meat, pulled pork or chicken), ready-made custard (tinned or carton - not powder), sugar 500g (not larger), potato smash, pasta sauces, tinned tomatoes, tinned rice pudding, jam/honey, tinned fruit in juice (not prunes or grapefruit), snack bars, chocolate, crisps, liquid or bar soap, washing up liquid (not family sized bottles), laundry liquid/powder (not family sized), toothpaste, single or duo wrapped toothbrushes, toilet rolls.
