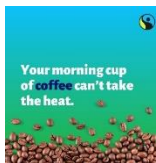
Farmers and workers cannot be left alone in a climate crisis they did not cause

Climate change is having a significant impact on banana production - the impact of climate change on banana farming has already caused banana production to decline by up to 50% in some regions.

Coffee farmers and workers are facing a crisis as climate change disrupts their delicate crops and takes a toll on coffee production, jeopardising the livelihoods of millions and the future of this beloved beverage.

Cocoa is a delicate crop that requires specific climatic conditions to thrive, but rising temperatures, changes in rainfall patterns, and more extreme weather events are making it increasingly difficult to grow.

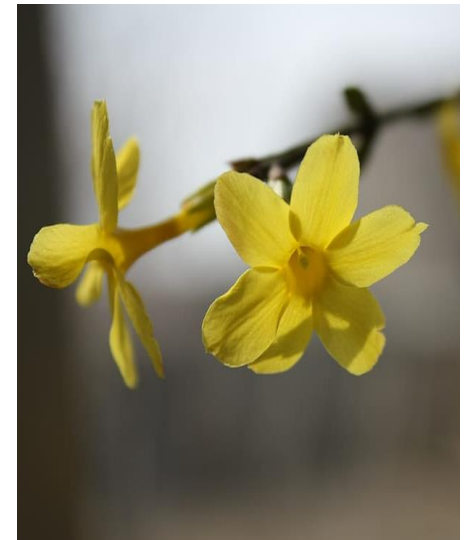

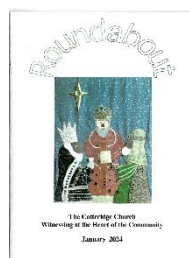
