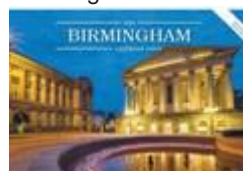

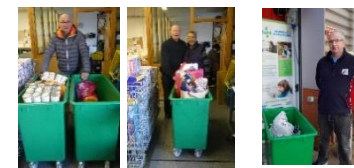

Urgently needed
 Tinned tomatoes, pasta sauce, rice (500g), tinned fish (tuna, mackerel, sardines), jam/honey, chocolate bars, tinned rice pudding, instant hot chocolate (not cocoa powder), tinned/carton ready-made custard, cereal (not greater than 500g), liquid/bar soap, gender neutral shower gel and shampoo, washing up liquid
 Christmas items: tinned ham, tinned salmon, tinned potatoes, tinned peas, tinned carrots, chocolate bars
 Christian Aid in Gaza has been working with the poorest and most vulnerable people in the Middle East since the early 1950s, when we provided humanitarian relief to Palestinian refugees. Christian Aid established partners in Gaza who are responding as best they can, under intense pressure, with medical relief and community-led initiatives such as food, shelter, sanitation and cash. However, it is extremely dangerous to move around, and supplies of essentials are running perilously low. In southern Gaza, our partner is responding to those most recently displaced to south Gaza as a result of the war.
