**Emergency - What's happening?**

As well as changing to a delivery service, we have increased the number of food parcels a client/family is eligible to receive. Our volunteers are now delivering food using their own vehicles to S and SW Postcodes B13, B14, B29, B30, B31, B38, B45 and sometimes B47, only the south in B32 and B17 and on Tuesdays and Fridays only.

**Last week** we fed 175 people (89 adults 86 children) on 60 vouchers

Tuesday 28 vouchers 42 adults 38 children total 80

Friday 32 vouchers 47 adults 48 children total 95

The total amount of food used was 1643 kgs

Donations totalled 1107kgs

**Urgently needed** Smash, rice pudding, tinned potato, custard, hot chocolate, Blue milk long life. Long life fruit juice, macaroni cheese, toothpaste, single wrapped toothbrushes, disposable razors, shampoo, deodorant, laundry liquid/powder, sturdy bags for life
