B30 Foodbank – w/e October 10th 2020

The Foodbank is operating an Emergency Food Delivery Service from the Warehouse until the 23rd October, this is when the clocks go back. From the 27th October clients, or their representatives will need to collect their own food parcels from the Friends Meeting House in Cotteridge. Times of operation will be available soon.
