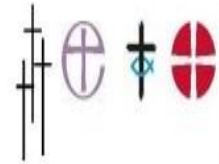
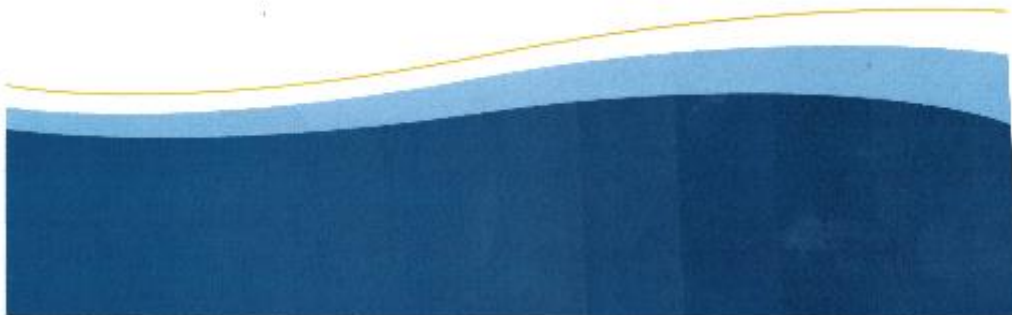

**We received in 2024k and gave out 2437k feeding 292 people of 133 vouchers**

**Our most urgent needs are rice 500k, tinned spaghetti and tinned vegetables**



**Last month the foodbank fed 1154 clients on 545 vouchers**

**We urgently need tinned spaghetti and tinned meat**

**Urgently needed**  
Tinned spaghetti, tinned tomatoes, baked beans, pasta shapes, rice (500g), tinned/carton instant custard, tinned meat /meat products, UHT semi-skimmed milk, chocolate bars, tinned soup, tinned rice pudding, instant noodles, sweet biscuits (not multi-packs, as they often have no ingredients listed on the packs inside), tinned vegetables (carrots, peas, sweetcorn), liquid/bar soap, tampons, gender neutral shampoo and shower gel.
