We received in donations of 1698k and gave out 3906k. 2602k to 232 B30 Foodbank clients, and 1304k to other foodbanks or similar

Needed urgently (red on app)

Sugar (500g bags), Disposable razors, washing up liquid, shampoo, UHT semi-skimmed milk (green); UHT whole milk (blue)

Low in stock (amber on app)

Cereal, porridge, Tinned meat (ham, corned beef, pork slices, pulled pork), Tinned fruit in juice, tinned or packet custard (not powder), Potato smash, Instant hot chocolate (made up with hot water, not milk), Instant coffee, Jam, honey, peanut butter, crisps, Long life fruit juice, Tinned tomatoes, Tinned spaghetti, Tinned rice pudding, Pasta sauces, Squash, tinned fish (not tuna), Shower gel, Soap bars, Toothbrushes (single or pair wrapped), Toothpaste, Sanitary towels (not tampons), Sturdy bags for life.

Well stocked and do not need (green on app)

Baked beans, teabags (40 and 80 bags), Pasta shapes, Dry spaghetti, Tinned macaroni cheese, Tinned meat products (sausages in beans, spaghetti bolonaise, meat balls, etc), Tinned Vegetables and pulses, Tinned/packet soup, Tinned Tuna, Rice, Tinned potatoes, Treats/snack bars, Bottled water, large bottles of coke/pop, Pet food, Baby food, milk, toiletries or nappies, Dairy-free milk, gluten-free items, Noodle pots/sachets, Biscuits, Male and female specific toiletries, Toilet rolls, Cooking ingredients, Plastic Carrier bags,
