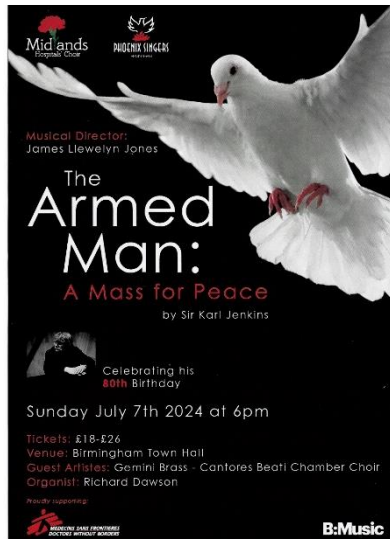

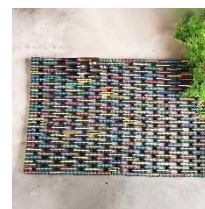

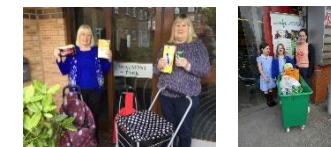

### Urgently needed
