Home Learning and Times Table Rock Stars . . .

One task per week is expected to be completed; please encourage your children to complete these tasks. Not handing in their Home Learning will mean that your child does not earn all of their Golden Time on a Friday.
 - All children should now have received a Times Table Rock Stars log in which they can use at home and in school to practice their times tables. This is a fantastic resource that encourages your child to develop their times tables knowledge.
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Reading . . .

- We would really love every child in Robin Class to read aloud daily to an adult. This can be recorded in their reading record with any comments. We are really focusing on asking questions to check the children's understanding of what they have read; asking your child simple questions about what you have read together would certainly help this.
- We expect children to bring in their reading books and reading records into class every morning as this will enable us to see how often they read as well as reply to any notes you may have written.
