KS2 maths workshops—dates for KS1 to be confirmed

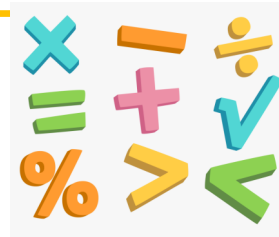
The sessions will be year group specific and aimed at giving you information about the school calculation policy and the approaches that we use in school.
