Mathematics

- The number system; place value, ordering and comparing four, five and six digit numbers, negative numbers and decimals and Roman Numerals
- Addition and subtraction using written methods, solving real life problems by estimating first.
- Multiplication facts and their corresponding divisions and consolidate both written and mental methods.
- Shape and space, identifying, classifying and sorting 2 and 3 D shapes, symmetry: co ordinates

- Describe the work of some key individuals at the time.

The Anglo Saxons

Creative and Expressive Arts –

Art – Stop Motion Animation linked to the Anglo Saxon Myth of Beowulf

Music – Composition around Anglo Saxon story telling.

DT – Researching and preparing foods that would have been available in Anglo-Saxon Time and designing and making Anglo Saxon Jewellery

Computing – Keeping safe online.

English -We will be looking at the following text types.

- **Myths and Legends** – Boewulf by Michael Morpergo
- **Historical Narrative** - Anglo Saxon Boy by Tony Bradman
- **Gothic Novel** - Goth Girl by Chris Riddell
- **Poetry**

We will be using the texts to explore different aspects of Grammar; features of the different text types; vocabulary and syntax.

In spelling we will be following the **No Nonsense** spelling programme and focussing on strategies for learning Y 3/4 common exception Words.

Science – Animals including Humans.
