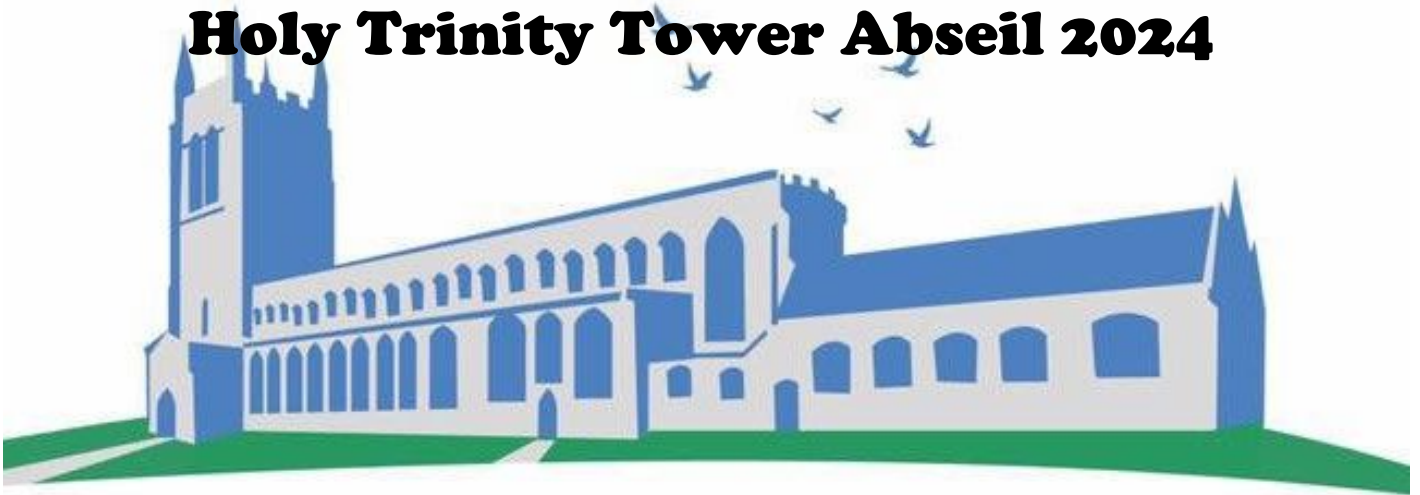


Holy Trinity Tower Abseil 2024



Participant Information

Welcome

Firstly, thanks are in order.

Holy Trinity church is an important piece of history that stretches back hundreds of years, commanding the village skyline and making Long Melford immediately recognisable.

Today it acts as a centre of worship but is a vital element of the community in other ways. Long Melford Primary School frequently use the ample space for large school events, services and assemblies. Most importantly for the Scouts, Holy Trinity serves as a host for the entire district for St George's Day parade and services.

Your abseiling contribution will go towards the fabric and maintenance of this extraordinary building not only to preserve an historical treasure but to help maintain it for its vital community use today.

Of course, we hope you have a great deal of fun while you're at it!

Fundraising

As you will be aware, participants are asked to contribute.

Firstly, with a payment of £20 to secure one of the limited number of spaces available.

Secondly, to fundraise a minimum of £80 by whatever means you choose.

The simplest and most common way is through sponsorship. A sponsorship form is included in this pack so you don't need to go hunting online.

Others may opt to set up a Just Giving style page (or other online fundraising page), the choice is yours.

Securing your space & deposit

To secure your space you must do the following:

- Return a completed consent form.

This can be completed digitally and returned by email or printed and completed manually. Manually completed forms can be scanned and returned by email (lyncarvell@hotmail.com) or posted to 27 Swanfield, Long Melford, CO10 9EZ.

- Pay £20 deposit directly to Holy Trinity, ideally by bank transfer.

(e.g. TA J SMITH)

This is so that funds can be confirmed and allocated correctly. Without the correct reference we have no way of confirming the payment.

- Under 16's must also return a completed parental consent form.

Once completed forms and deposit are received you will get email confirmation, a day and time slot will also be allocated to you.

We will go to every effort to provide a time that best suits you. As spaces are filled this will become more difficult so it is advisable to secure your space as early as possible.

Sponsorship

As with most sponsored events, you are responsible for raising and collection your own sponsorship money.

After the abseiling weekend we ask that you collect and pay the money within 21 day directly to Holy Trinity. Ideally by bank transfer (Details above). **PLEASE NOTE:** you must use the reference as described above – **TA [Initial] [surname]** so we can correctly allocate the funds.

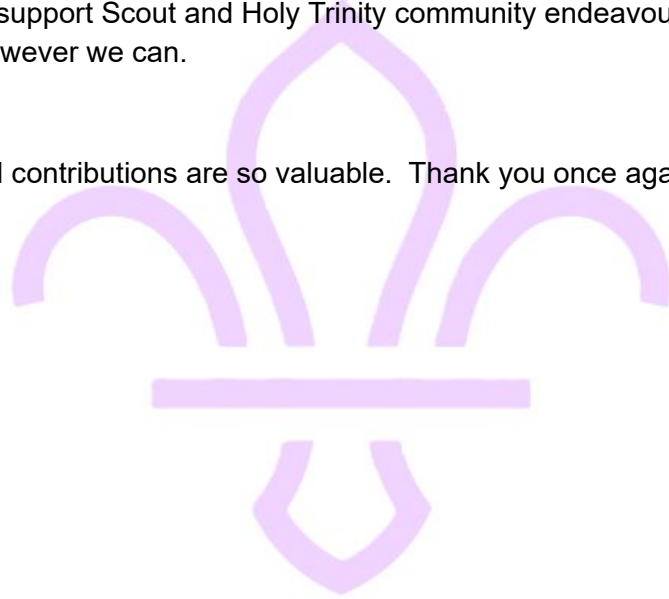
If you are unable to collect and pay forward the sponsorship funds in the requested time please get in touch to let us know.

1st Long Melford Scouts, Holy Trinity and everyone involved would like to send our very best wishes to you. We hope that you have the most enjoyable experience possible.

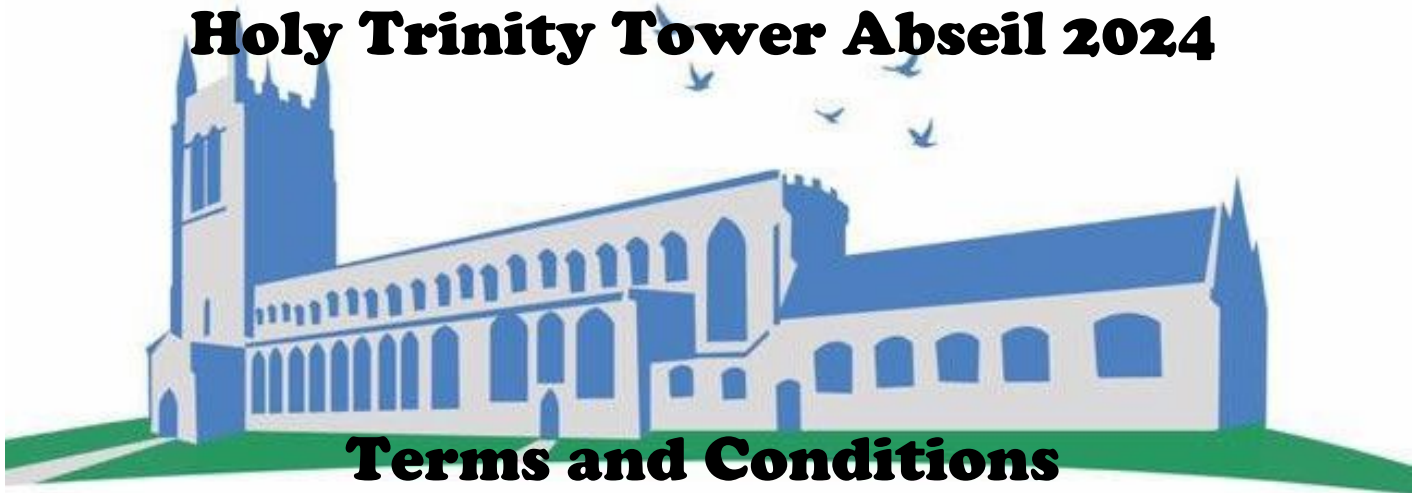

Thank you for your interest in participating in the Holy Trinity Tower Abseiling event. Before you proceed please read the terms and conditions carefully.

The event is run by 1st Long Melford Scouts and neither Holy Trinity nor the Long Melford PCC bears any responsibility or any liability for any injuries or losses suffered.

In order to take part in the activity, participants must:

- Be over the age of 10 years old.
- Weigh no more than 18 stone.
- Be physically fit and able enough to climb the church tower unaided.

Participants must declare any known injuries or illnesses such as any heart conditions prior to the event and take part in the event at their own risk.

Participants will be advised in the information pack of appropriate dress and, if necessary, instructions on tying back long hair and agree to adhere to the requirements.

Participants agree to pay a non-refundable deposit of £20 to secure a place on the abseiling event.

Further to this, participants will then raise a minimum of £80 prior to the event. This may be done via sponsorship, other fundraising methods or paid privately by the participant.

Funds raised must be paid within 21 days following the event. Details of how to make payment will be included in the information pack.

The organisers will allocate participants a date and time that their abseil will take place. While every effort will be made to accommodate the wishes of the participants, it may not always be possible to allocate the first choice.

Time and date allocations will be decided ultimately by the event organisers.

Any antisocial or disruptive behaviour, or refusal to follow the instructions of the climbing team or event organisers will result in their abseil being cancelled.

The event organisers will be taking photographs and/or videos of the event throughout and may use them for publication in publicity, local media including social media as well as their own in-house publications.

Participants who do not consent to have their image used are advised that no images taken which contain them will be used.

Any data collected by the event organisers is subject to GDPR regulations and will be destroyed following the event once fundraising payment has been received.


In the event that the abseiling cannot take place on the scheduled dates, the event organisers will make every effort to contact all participants at the earliest opportunity.

Also in the above event, a new date will be arranged and all participants will be advised in a timely manner.

In the event that the abseil is postponed and the participants do not wish to take part at a later date, the participant is not obliged to pay any funds they may have raised.

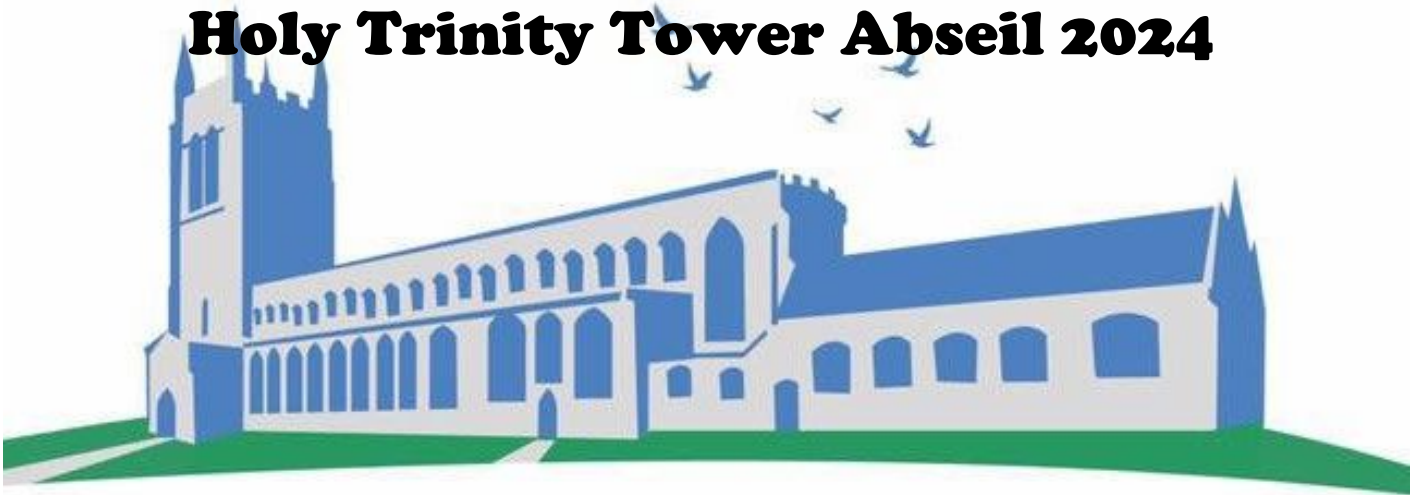
The deposit of £20 remains non-refundable.



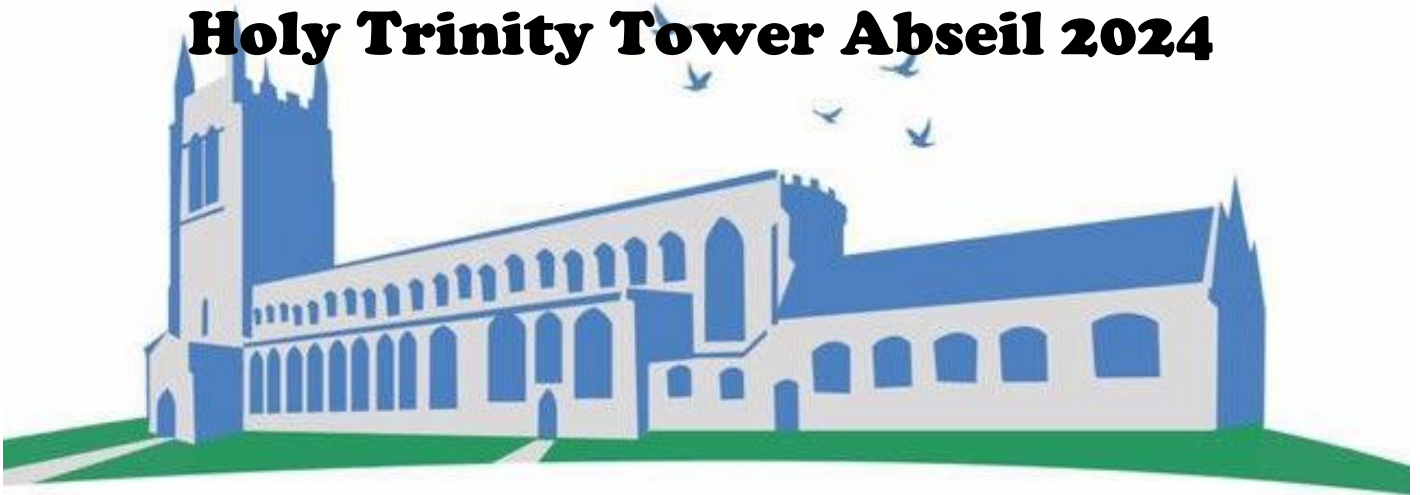
