### **Prayer of Confession**

Let us say together

We are sorry and ashamed, and repent of all our sins. For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, who died for us, forgive us all that is past and lead us our from darkness to walk as children of light.**

### **The Act of Remembrance**

Therefore in a state of grace, we come before Almighty God and remember those we love but see no longer.

The lighting of a candle is a token of the love which has shone from our loved ones into our lives; we light a candle to their memory.

We remain in silence for a few moments.

Let us say together.

**Heavenly Father, we hold before you our special memories and love for our loved ones who have died. Work in all of us now to heal our pain and sadness. Give us the serenity to accept the things we cannot change; the courage to change the things we can; and the wisdom to know the difference.**
