Staff and volunteers have had a training/refresher day in preparation for us opening up to visitors, our first time having visitors inside since March 2020, but we are ready. We will be having a Grand Opening at the end of March. Our needs this week are tinned fruit, microwave rice & dry rice, jelly cubes, Fray Bentos pies and big soup. Thank you.

This week on Monday when we delivered a families food parcel, we were told how they had ran out of electric on the Friday and were not paid till the following Thursday, the children had been sat in the home with no heating or lighting all weekend. We took their meter key and put funds on the key to enable them to have electricity, this is so sad, but not unusual. There are lots of families in crisis in this way in our communities, please pray for Gods provision for them and wisdom for us to find a way to help these families in crisis. *Donations can be placed in the boxes in the foyer.*
