Our community supper is now seeing 30+ people including families & children, sit down & eat together & just do community. Our furniture bank has seen a rise in referrals along with those in fuel poverty. It is so sad that there's a need for families who have to choose between food & electric. After a busy couple of years our foodbank+ is needed more than ever. 70% of those who have needed us this year have been first time users.
