Message From Christchurch Foodbank+ - Thank you for your continued and generous support of the work we do. People often ask what you do when the Foodbank is closed. Today: The team and volunteers moved two families into empty properties through our Furniture Bank project, organised a fridge freezer and cooker for delivery, delivered 3 food parcels out to people unable to make it down to us at St Joes and arranged for 5 households to visit us during our session tomorrow for help with food, electric, debt and budget advice, prepared steak pie and apple crumble to feed 49 at our community supper this evening at 5.30pm, arrange fruit and veg contents of fridge lunch bags and slow cooker recipe bags ready for the next session. Phew what a fabulous staff and volunteer team we have. Our needs are tinned/boxes tomatoes, tinned fruit, custard, meat meals (curry, stew, chilli) Fray Bentos pies and small Easter treats.
