## **Simple. Jesus is Gospel (Colossians 1:15-23)**

1. Reflect back on the teaching from 24th of January, "*Jesus is Gospel.*" How, if at all, did this teaching impact the past 7-10 days of your life? [*Jesus + nothing = everything*]
2. What is Paul writing about in verses 15-23? What jumps out or strikes you afresh?
3. What does it mean to be the *image of God*?
4. How does Jesus help us to know more about who God is?
5. Tom used a parallel between Adam and Jesus to talk about the image of God, how does this help us to understand more about who Jesus is?
6. How does Jesus' supremacy affect our lives?
7. What do you think is meant by the "fullness of God" and what implications does this have for who Jesus is?
8. How does knowing of God's desire to reconcile with us affect the way that we live? Does it change the way we pray or read the Bible?
9. How should we respond knowing the great lengths Christ went to in order to bring us back to him?
10. What does "continuing in the faith" look like?
11. Spend some time reflecting on who Christ is and give some prayers of praise to him.
