### Activity



### Prayer

### Evening Bible Reading

### Activity

Bumble Bee Breath

Next, with their mouth still closed, have them make a humming or buzzing noise (like a bumblebee) as they exhale. Your child can also cup their hands around their ears to amplify the buzzing sound. Repeat twice.


### Application

### Morning Bible Reading

Instead, they were amazed by his answer, and they became silent.

### Prayer



Dear Lord,

### Morning Bible Reading

READ

Luke 21

Verses 1 - 4

'Just then he looked up and saw the rich people dropping offerings in the collection plate. Then he saw a poor widow put in two pennies. He said, "The plain truth is that this widow has given by far the largest offering today. All these others made offerings that they'll never miss; she gave extravagantly what she couldn't afford - she gave her all!" (MSG)

### Activity

Gather some loose change and see who can build the tallest tower before it falls. Now think of the women on the story all she had was a few coins. Think about how we could be generous with our lives. Maybe make a picture with the coins and show a friend. Or buy a friend some sweets using the coins you have to bless them.

### Application

As we consider our tower and pennies let's reflect on the passage in Luke 21. Jesus looks at our hearts, when we choose to be generous to others he is so pleased of us. Jesus shares that our lives on earth are only temporary so we need to make the most of this time and try our best to be loving and generous to those around us. How does being generous to others make you feel?

How might Jesus feel when you are generous?

### Prayer

### Evening Bible Reading

READ

Mark 14 : 1 - 11

Verses 6 - 8

But Jesus replied, "Leave her alone. Why criticise her for doing such a good thing to me? You will always have the poor among you, and you can help them whenever you want to. But you will not always have me. She has done what she could..." (NIV)

### Activity

### Application

When we try to encourage people tomorrow why not choose people who would not normally be encouraged? Maybe a cleaner, bin workers, your teacher? We want to mirror the enthusiasm the woman showed in this story.

### Morning Bible Reading

READ

Luke 22 : 1 - 65

Verse 20 - 23

In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you. But the hand of him who is going to betray me is with mine on the table. The Son of Man will go as it has been decreed. But woe to that man who betrays him!" They began to question among themselves which of them it might be who would do this. (NIV)

### Activity

Watch the Video of the Last Supper and Jesus' arrest.

Spend some time reflecting on what the last supper meant. We will look at the cup which spoke of the Blood of Jesus which he shed for us. Using one half of the a piece of paper draw a cup, inside of it write down what you would like to say sorry to God about.

Jesus broke bread to symbolise his love for us. Next to the cup draw a loaf of bread, inside write down some things you are thankful for.

### Application

As you draw and write down what you are sorry and thankful for. The cup and bread remind Christians of the sacrifice Jesus was making for our lives and explained the new covenant. We give thanks for we can say sorry and be forgiven by God. It is wonderful that we can know life in full through this new covenant. Talk about what you are thankful for and pray together. Thanking God for what Jesus did for us.

### Prayer

Dear God,

As we are still may we be reminded of Jesus and the last supper. We are so thankful we are able to come to you Lord and say sorry and be forgiven. We pray we will never forget what Jesus said. We thank you for your love and we pray we would always be reminded of your love for us.

### Evening Bible Reading

READ

Isaiah 50 : 4 - 10

Verse 10

Who among you fears the Lord and obeys the word of his servant?

Let the one who walks in the dark who has no light, trust the name of the Lord on rely on their God. (NLT)

### Morning Bible Reading

Luke 23 : 13 - 16 & 24

Then Pilate called together the leading priests and other religious leaders, along with the people, and he announced his verdict. "You brought this man to me, accusing him of leading a revolt. I have examined him thoroughly on this point in your presence and find him innocent. Herod came to the same conclusion and sent him back to us. Nothing this man has done calls for the death penalty. So I will have him flogged and then I will release him"

So pilate sentenced Jesus to die as they demanded.(NLT)

He will always forgive us for the things we have done wrong if we are truly sorry.


He cares for us so much and wants us to know him more and more each day.

### Prayer


Dear God,
