This time I would like you to focus on why everyone should try and look after our world better.

Activities:

1. Think about what is exciting and special in our world. Can you find some pictures of lovely things in our world from magazines and create a collage? Alternatively, you could draw some.
2. Create a poster with a snappy slogan to encourage everyone to look after our world better.
3. Think about why it is important to look after our world - make a list of reasons.
4. Go outside in your garden or take a walk with a grown up. Look for something lovely that you can see, hear, smell, touch and feel.

Write a short poem using your observations. You could use this planning frame to help you if you would like to.

I see...

I hear...

I smell...

I touch...

I feel...

Remember your fantastic 'WOW' adjectives and try and use expanded noun phrases.

This will make your poem more vivid and enable the reader to get a really clear picture in their head, whilst reading your poem.

e.g. I see fluffy, white clouds in the sky above.

Extension (only if you would like to do this and have the time):

Write a simple prayer thanking God for our wonderful world.
