NHS 111 First: On Tuesday 1st December, NHS England and NHS Improvement launched the next phase of the 'Help Us, Help You' campaign which focuses on the NHS 111 Service as a new way of accessing A&E / Emergency Departments.

The aim of this campaign is to direct people to use 111 first when they have an urgent, but not life-threatening, medical need rather than going straight to A&E.

If the patient needs urgent care, NHS 111 can now book them in to be seen quickly and safely in A&E / Emergency Departments.
