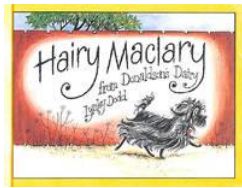
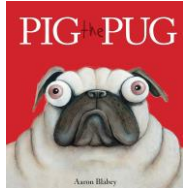
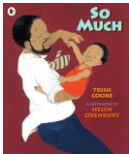
EYFS
