

KS2 Performance Data 2019

Outcomes for our school for 2019 (the last time the Government published primary school performance data) are listed below (National Average figures in brackets).

Reading

Average scaled score: 104.7 (104)

Percentage of pupils achieving expected standard or above: 80% (73%)

Percentage of pupils achieving a high standard: 0% (27%)

Writing

Percentage of pupils achieving expected standard or above: 100% (78%)

Percentage of pupils achieving a high standard: 20% (20%)

Grammar

Average scaled score: 105.9 (106)

Percentage of pupils achieving expected standard or above: 100% (78%)

Percentage of pupils achieving a high standard: 40% (36%)

<u>Maths</u>

Average scaled score: 104.9 (105)

Percentage of pupils achieving expected standard or above: 100% (79%)

Percentage of pupils achieving a high standard: 40% (27%)

Reading, Writing and Maths Combined

The percentage of children achieving the expected standard or better in reading,

writing and maths: 80 % (65%)

The percentage of children achieving a high level of attainment in reading, writing and

maths: 0% (11%)

<u>Progress</u>

DfE expected progress is measured by the average progress made nationally by pupils with similar starting points at KS1, expressed as 0; a minus score is less than expected progress, a plus score is better than expected progress.
