

Displacement worldwide


- Terminology and politics: displacement, refugees, international protection, IDPs, asylum, migrants
- 117.3 million displaced, with 43.4 million refugees
- 75% hosted in low- and middle-income countries and 69% hosted in neighbouring countries
- 73 per cent originate from just 5 countries, can you guess which?
- **Did you know?** Children make up 30% of world population but 40% of refugees



UNHCR Global Trends report 2023

Asylum applications in Europe: how do we compare?

- Asylum: not resettlement schemes (e.g. Ukraine)
- 2022: Most applications: Germany (243,800), France (156,500), Spain (117,900), Austria (112,200), and Italy (84,300) = 2/3 of all applications
- Per capita view – “fair share” argument
- Per 10,000 population:
 - Cyprus 248 applications per 10,000
 - EU average 22 applications
 - UK 13 applications



Positive decisions in Europe: how do we compare?

- Germany, France and Spain most grants of asylum
- Per 10,000 population:
 - Austria 19 positive decisions
 - EU average 7
 - UK 3

Seeking asylum in the UK

At a glance

- Asylum seekers make up around 10% of overall net migration
- June 2022 - June 2023 - 44,460 crossed in small boats = 3.7% total migration for that year
- The annual number of asylum applications to the UK peaked in 2002 at 84,132
- In 2023, 67,337 applications
- Entitled to between £8.86 - £49.18 p/w
- Not allowed to work
- Average waiting time 1-3 years
- Short notice evictions - homelessness

What is RSE?

- Registered charity - short-term, dignified support at times of urgent need
- Founded in 2016 in response to European governmental failure
- Always evolving to meet emerging needs
- 3 pillars:
 - Dignity Centres
 - Crisis response
 - Advocating for an alternative
- >152,000 people in Greece, Bangladesh, Mexico, Türkiye, Cyprus, Moldova and the UK



Crisis response

- Bangladesh 2017, Mexico 2018
- Moldova March 2022:
 - 2 week set up
 - 1,200 people a week
 - Supporting Moldovans
- Türkiye February 2023:
 - 2 million temporary shelter
 - Local women's co-op
 - 4 weeks:
 - 10,362 people served
 - 2,240 hygiene kits
 - 500 food bags
