- No right of ownership of the grave will be issued to me as it remains the property of the church.

- No guarantee can be made to the actual number of burials in a plot. This will be affected by the type and size of coffins or caskets and the nature of the ground.
- Unless a faculty is obtained by me the Church have absolute discretion as to future interments. I understand that the family's wishes are observed whenever practicable.
- The Church has strict regulations governing memorials, Inscriptions, dictated by diocesan regulations and faculties. No items may be placed on the plot or in the churchyard unless they have been approved through the faculty process.²
