SEBA Training

First Aid Training:

Saturday 17 July 2021, 9.30am-4.30pm

Headcorn Baptist Church, TN27 9SB

Now that covid restrictions have been lifted slightly and we are able to resume some of our training albeit in smaller numbers due to restrictions, we have a First Aid Training day arranged at Headcorn Baptist Church. This is a full day's training for an "Emergency First Aid at work" qualification.

The course:

- Takes about 6 hours, 9.30am – 4.30pm
- Costs £50.00 per person . Please pay by BAC Payment to Reliance Bank, Sort Code 60-01-73 Account number 00218212 Ref Your name, FA July 17
- Can cater for a maximum of 12 candidates, although during covid restrictions we are only having 8 Candidates so that we don't share dummies.
- Qualifies you for three years although changes in regulations do encourage annual refresher training to be held as well.
- Covers basic first aid suitable for volunteers / staff who are helping with events etc (Understanding the role of a first aider / dealing with unconscious casualties / basic CPR / Wounds and bleeding / choking / shock / minor injuries)
- Please note the course includes both lecture style learning and also practical physical elements (e.g. CPR, and recovery position). You need to physically be able to complete both aspects in order to be able to pass the course. Please wear loose clothing, and trousers, not skirts as you will be down on the floor at times!
- Candidates need to be over 16 years of age.

Please note, spaces are limited, so booking quick is essential - to book a place, please contact Pam Kerley asap pam.admin@seba-baptist.org.uk (if you are unable to pay via BACS, you can also pay by cheque - please ask Pam for the details).

Safeguarding Training:

As a temporary measure (until we are able to return to face-to-face training) the Baptist Union have brought out an Excellence in Safeguarding Update film (+ optional 45-minute Q&A session, via Zoom, for those who would appreciate the opportunity of the extra support)

- We have had a huge response to the Excellence in Safeguarding Training Update which has been very positive. This will continue to be available to all who require training for safeguarding going forward. For us to be able to manage this we will be changing the booking system. After May 31st you will not be able to book training through Pam, whilst we transfer the access to an on line booking system. *This means there will be no availability for booking the training during the whole month of June (this does not affect the viewing availability of the training video, for those who have already booked it). As the 11 June deadline has now passed, anyone who returns a feedback form (under the old system) will not receive a confirmation certificate. **The new online booking system will launch on 1 July.***

We are now taking an exciting step forward to extend our work and, in conjunction with local churches in the area, to develop a chaplaincy to reach out to older people in Bookham and District.

We are looking for someone who loves working with older people. For someone with Christian faith who will work ecumenically across all church traditions, with people of other faiths and with no faith.

We want to recruit to a new post: ANNA CHAPLAIN for Bookham and District

- The post is for 20 hours a week
- Salary from £14,000 to £15,600 per annum depending on skills and qualifications.
- Flexible working with be required involving the occasional Sunday and evening responsibility.
- Annual leave is 28 days including statutory Bank Holidays.

Your office base will be at Eastwick Road Church, Eastwick Road, Great Bookham, KT23 4BE.

TMP has been authorised by the Bible Reading Fellowship (BRF) to establish this post, which is one of a growing number of Anna Chaplains across the country, with a specific ministry to older people. Our Anna chaplain will join a team of volunteers who are already working in the local care home and in a telephone befriending service.

Your responsibilities will include:

- Offering spiritual support to older people whether they are living in their own home, care homes or sheltered housing.
- Supporting and training family and professional carers in the delivery of spiritual care as part of an old person's care needs.
- Advocating for the needs of older people across our churches and the wider community

The appointment is subject to a medical, and an enhanced DBS check from the Disclosure and Barring Service.
