

Guidance to follow for attending Sunday services at Forest Gate Church

The government has now lifted all Covid-19 restrictions relating to public buildings, considering this the trustees of the building have agreed the following:

- There is no need for people to wear masks. However, under special circumstances, we may ask people to wear one around those who are vulnerable.
- Masks and hand sanitiser will continue to be available at the welcome desk for those who choose to use them. It is acknowledged that we need mutual respect for each other in our choices.
- We will open at least 2 windows to allow fresh air and continue to have the CO₂ monitor in place. We will use this to determine if more windows or doors need to be opened.
- Please do not enter the building if you have had a positive Covid test or any Covid symptoms.
- If someone in your household has Covid we respectfully request that members of that household take a lateral flow test before attending any church activity.
