Our parish Annual Parochial Church Meeting will take place at St Paul's next Sunday 25th April at 11.15pm. Like last year this will allow people to gather after the morning services. The hall and church will be open to allow everyone to attend safely with social distancing. You must attend in person, or notify the chairman of your proxy, to vote but the meeting can be viewed on Zoom, link on previous page.

As usual we will elect Churchwardens and Parochial Church Council members, if you would like to serve the church in these important capacities and consider standing, please contact Canon John ASAP to discuss the duties involved and how to put your name forward. To help save paper the reports and accounts will be sent out this week to the email list, if you require a printed copy you will need to request one, although some will be available at the meeting.

Salisbury Bequest Committee

A total of 14 suggestions were received by the committee, who have now come up with a shortlist of 4 items. At the top is improving the audio-visual facilities in both churches, so that zoomed services (including music) are of better quality and a wider range of technological resources are available to clergy and other users of our buildings.

Any moneys remaining after this will go to repairing the roof at St Paul's (a requirement arising from the Quinquennial report) and removing the pews from the North Aisle of St Mary's to allow for a more flexible and social space. Improving the heating at St Paul's is also on the list. At the moment, the wardens are seeking estimates for both the audio-visual work and the roof repair.

More information to follow when decisions based on more detailed information are made. Thank you to all who came up with such interesting and innovative ideas - we hope to be able to implement at least some of them from our own fundraising efforts in the future.
