What do you need?

twigs

wool

strong glue/glue gun

Monroe, Elodie and Fleur from St. John's Thornham have made decorations using twigs fallen from trees and wool taken from an old jumper!



1. Collect four small sticks, let them dry and unpick an old woolly jumper to get the threads.



2. Use three sticks to make a triangle shape for your tree. Snap your stick to create a short trunk.



3. Take a glue gun or super glue and add glue to each end of the sticks to join the triangle together.



4. Use the wool to decorate the tree in different ways. You can wrap up and down, around one twig or across.



5. Cut out a star from scrap paper for a star and stick it at the top of your tree.
