What do you need?

Recyclable card, pencil crayon sharpening's, glue and felt tips to decorate!

1. To start, fold the recycled cardboard in half.



2. Secondly, use a variety of blunt coloured pencils and sharpen them carefully so that you get different lengths of pencil sharpening's.



3. Using a glue stick, make a triangle or individual curved lines to outline your Christmas tree.



4. Gently, unravel and stick your shavings to create your tree.



5. Next, decorate your tree with felt tips.



6. Then, write your Christmas message – we added our favourite Christmas bible quotes.



7. Finally, give your card to someone special to enjoy!
