It is a legal requirement for all churchwardens to be admitted into office each year.

The act of admission at the Visitation is an important and significant event. Accordingly, members of clergy and Parochial Church Councils are invited to accompany their churchwardens to the Visitation.

NOTES FOR CLERGY AND ALL CHURCHWARDENS ELECTED AT THE 2022 ANNUAL MEETING:

- If a churchwarden cannot attend the date for the visitation service for their deanery, they may attend and be admitted at any alternative visitation service in the diocese.
- An elected churchwarden will lose the right to be admitted into their office if they do not attend a visitation service or complete alternative arrangements (which must be made directly with either an Archdeacon or the Diocesan Registrar) before **31 AUGUST** in the year in which they have been elected at the annual meeting of parishioners.
- All churchwardens (whether elected for the first time or re-elected for a further term) must make the declarations for the due execution of their office. Online forms can be found on the diocesan website www.manchester.anglican.org and searching for 'churchwarden admission'.
