PARISH OF ST. ANDREW BIGGLESWADE GUIDANCE IN RELATION TO OUR CHURCH RISK ASSESSMENT

It is a legal requirement for worshippers to wear a face covering during public worship.

Use of sanitiser, and 'track and trace' [either by use of QR code, or signing-in] is now required.

Regular and consistent ventilation of Church and Chapter House remains imperative.

For the foreseeable future, Communion will be administered in one kind to the congregation, and processions will not be part of worship. Major acts of worship will continue to be available via Zoom: access details via website and pew sheet. The possibility for social distancing remains, if required; requests should be addressed to Sidespeople or Churchwardens.
