The Programme Manager will be responsible for helping to design and deliver strategic projects that successfully enable the achievement of the outcomes set out in the Diocesan Strategy. This includes ensuring the processing or applications for Strategic Mission Funding and that robust governance is in place to monitor and evaluate projects.

The Programme Manager will also be responsible for the assisting in the setting up and delivery of the Youth Hubs Pilot project, which is being funded jointly by the Central Church's Diocesan Investment Programme and the Diocesan Strategic Mission Fund. The aim of the pilot is to produce a replicable model for youth mission and evangelism in a rural context.
