FORM OF INDEMNITY

This Form of Indemnity must be completed in all cases of interment in a purchased grave if the authority of the owner cannot be obtained or established or the Deed of Grant of Right of Burial is otherwise misplaced and cannot be produced. Where the grave number cannot be given, the name and date of the last interment in the grave will be required. The onus of providing the full and correct particulars of the grave to be opened is an obligation of the grave owner or his/her legal representative.
