Date: Saturday 6th June 2020

Venue: Mendip Activity Centre - Churchill, N.Somerset (BS25 5PQ)

Format for the day:

- 09:30 Arrive at Centre / registration @ forest school area.
- 10:00 Welcome / Family Max team (refreshments)
- 10:30 Tobogganing session
- 11:30 Archery session
- 13:00 Picnic / forest school area
- 14:00 Frisbee Golf
- 16:30 Why not drive to the coast and enjoy fish'chips

Activities: All activities on the day are selected so that the whole family can have a go. Supervised by qualified staff, the Family Max Team will also be 'on hand' to ensure you and your family have a fun and safe time. For more information check out their website - www.mendip.me

Cost: £6.50 pays for one person (aged 5+yrs) to take part in the three activities.

Picnic lunch: As parents know their child's favourite sandwich, families are being asked to provide their own picnics. This ensures that any dietary requirements are catered for - the Family Max Team will provide light refreshments, marshmallows and snacks.
