## Remembrance Events in Wellington

It's coming up to the time of year where we remember Armistice Day.

Everyone is invited to attend the following events organised by the Royal British Legion and Wellington Town Council.

- On Sunday, November 5th, at 12 noon, there will be the Dedication of the Field of Remembrance at Wellington Baptist Church on South Street.
- On Saturday, November 11th, at 11 a.m., there will be a two-minute silence in the town centre to mark Armistice Day and reflect on the service of the Armed Forces.
- On Sunday, November 12th, the annual Remembrance parade will march from Wellington School to Wellington Park (at 2.55 p.m.) ahead of the Remembrance Service at the war memorial (at 3.15 p.m.). This service includes hymns, a two-minute silence, and the reading of the names of the fallen from World War I and II, as wreaths are laid at the memorial.
