Notes	 This policy: In brief – the Charity Commission recognise that parishes come under the Church of England's financial management and therefore do not insist on the financial policies stated in their guidance for charities. Instead they expect us to fulfil the policy requirement (and financial management) of the Church of England.

At St Mary's (the Minster), Ilminster, we welcome all gifts in wills, however large or small and we promise to use your gift to make a difference to our parish. We acknowledge gifts in whatever way the donor and/or his/her executors feel most appropriate to. Equally, we can make sure that gifts remain anonymous if the donor prefers.
