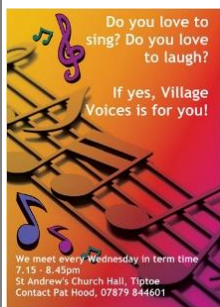
Singing for pleasure and fun.
