StreetLink Help with Homelessness:

Refer someone **over 18 years old** anytime to **StreetLink** by phone on 0300 500 0914, or visit www.streetlink.org.uk, or download the free mobile app.

Anyone **under 18 years old**, contact the Police on 999

STREETLINK helps members of the public to link rough sleepers with local services able to help them. They are a national service. They use local

outreach teams commissioned by local councils to support homeless people. They are not an emergency service, but link people to relevant local services.

To make a referral you need the person's consent either written or oral. If they do not give their consent, and you are still concerned for them or wish to alert local authorities, call StreetLink on 0300 500 0914, or visit www.streetlink.org.uk, or download the free mobile app.
