# BAPTISM

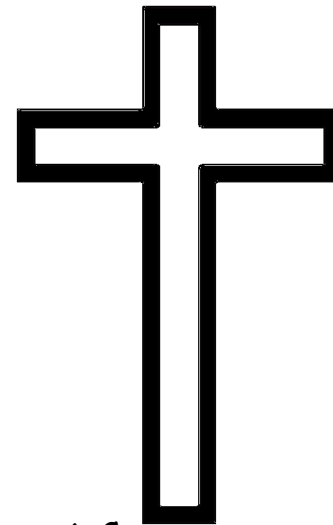

Before the service at the front of church you might see:

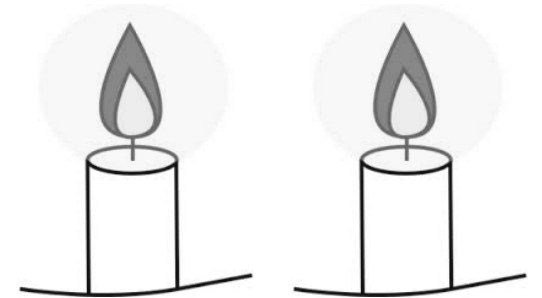


Shake hands to share Christ's peace with people

During the service you might hear:

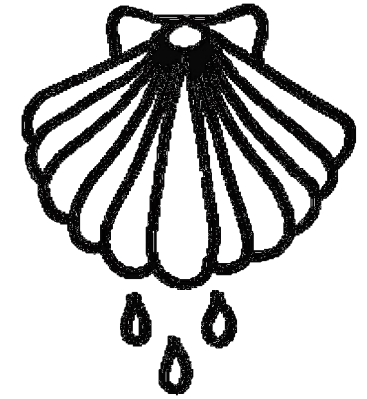


The choir and people singing praises to God

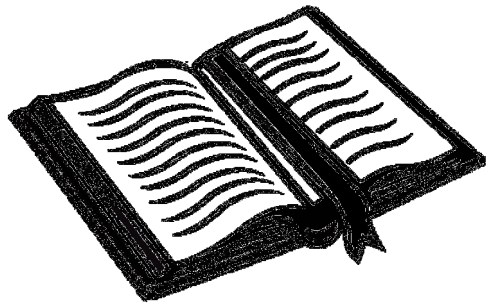
Other thing your might notice:
