

Dear friends

I am sure that you, like me, cannot believe what we are witnessing in our world at the moment. We maybe had dared to believe that we might be emerging out of the worst days we might see for a generation as COVID-19 became less of a threat - to most of us, at least. And then, all of a sudden, invasion and the beginnings, perhaps, of war in Ukraine.

You will be aware of what is happening, and perhaps unwilling to hear more - so I will not dwell too long on the facts of what is happening. But in the darkness, we need always to be reminded that the light is never far away. The Christian faith continues to proclaim that, 'The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.' (John 1.5)

At a time like this, just because I am a Christian does not mean that I have a greater handle on reality than anyone else. It has been an ever-present question and challenge for the Christian faith as to how we could live in a universe created and maintained by a loving and omnipotent God - and see children and innocent women and men killed by a totalitarian regime. Hundreds, thousands of books have been written trying to make sense of it all ... and the fact that they're still being written shows that an entirely satisfactory answer has not been proposed yet.

Truthfully, I don't understand. And I don't understand how my own life has been visited by its own misfortunes. No doubt, you have experienced (or are experiencing) things that feel entirely unfair, and seem to serve no purpose at all ... and we find ourselves asking where God is in it all, if God is anywhere at all.

All I can share with you is that I believe in a man who constantly shared with people that they were loved beyond measure by God - and he did this by speaking about love, and demonstrating love in his actions, his attitude, his embrace. Jesus himself experienced pain and suffering, misunderstanding and rejection, and at times cried out to heaven in his anguish. He promises to be with us all in the brightest moment of every day, and in the darkest moment of every night. It isn't a guarantee of safety, a promise that everything will 'be alright', even a hint that we will be able to make sense of it all.

But as refugees flee Ukraine ... as people we know lay in hospital beds ... as those we love draw their final breaths ... the promise is that God is with us in every moment. We are not alone and never can be, because God is present in the beating of every heart, the very energy that keeps us alive; God is in each moment of hope and love, and in each tear that we shed.

Sometimes faith is just a flicker of light ... but that light continues to shine in the darkness, and it is enough to guide us into the future. And as God is with us in every step (I believe), so we are making that journey together. So we encourage one another, love one another, help one another and believe in one another - and so the world is changed, one step at a time.

Lastly, please remember - if you ever need to talk, to be prayed with, to ask how to trust that God is with you, I am always available to every one of you, imperfect and flawed as I may be ... and I continue to pray, together with the Church community, for us all.



### The Garden in April

April showers brings forth flowers

April can have all 4 seasons in one month. Don't be tempted to plant tender plants outside even if the DIY stores and supermarkets have them. You may get away with it, but probably won't – we regularly get odd hard frosts any time up to the end May (although for the last 2 years we haven't).

**Pests:** Inspect new shoots on plants regularly for signs of early aphids and other pests. Squash them with your fingers where possible, rather than spraying.

**Lawns:** Sow seed. Apply a weed and feed if you didn't last month.

**Patios:** As you cleaned them last month remember why you have a patio. Clean the BBQ and get the celebratory wine out ready to welcome the odd warm day.

**Rhododendrons, Azaleas etc in pots:** Keep watered with Rainwater. Coffee grounds are acidic, so an occasional mulch of these will help if you have to use tap water. Remember the 7 inch rule – in order to soak down to the bottom of a 7 inch pot you would need an inch of rain. Water at

least fortnightly – more if we have a prolonged hot spell (you never know).

**Perennials:** put in any supports while the new growth is still short.

**Dahlias:** Plant tubers outside. Take cuttings from potted plants when they are about 4 inches long. Don't forget to label the cuttings – they all look broadly similar until they flower.

**Annuals:** finish off sowing hardy annuals, half hardies can be sown with protection in pots or trays. On warm days ventilate the greenhouse.

**Gladioli:** plant 4 – 6 inches (10-15cm) deep continue planting a few every couple of weeks until late June they will flower over a much longer period.

**Vegetables:** Sow in greenhouse or cold frame without heat: French beans (dwarf or climbing), runner beans, ridge cucumbers, sweet corn.

Sow /plant outdoors: broad beans, broccoli, cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, kale, lettuce (a few), peas, potatoes radishes (a few each week until July).

Plant out: Broad beans, cabbages, cauliflowers, leeks, lettuces, onion sets and peas.

**Harvest:** anything that is ready. Remember over-wintered plants such as leeks will run to seed when we get a few warm days together, so it is better to harvest them small by early May unless you want to keep some of the seed.

**Weeds:** Weeds are just wild flowers in the wrong place. If everybody allows just a small patch of wild flowers Mother Nature will be grateful. Hoe any that are unwanted on warm, dry days.

**Wild flower areas:** DO NOT APPLY FERTILISER. If the grass gets out of hand or there are invasive plants you don't want, dig or cut by hand and remove from the plot. The aim is to keep the fertility of the soil to a minimum and to allow wild flowers to seed.

**General:** The garden is there to enjoy. Stop and relax and admire your handiwork occasionally

Harling's Memorial Recreation Field.  
David Bailey

We fondly call it "The Rec' " but, as you know, its full title is 'The Memorial Recreation Field' –indicating that its existence has a deeper significance, as indeed it has. So, why is it a "Memorial?"-- and what or who does it serve to remember?

If you enter The Rec' via the West Harling Road, you will see two stone memorial plaques, one on each of the brick pillars that support the iron gate. Upon the left hand plaque is carved 'Harling Memorial Recreation Field. 1939—1945' and upon the other, ' Opened 5<sup>th</sup> September 1948'. This simple inscription underplays the hidden story behind its foundation soon after the war ended. The story of how 9 acres of open land became conveyed to the people of East Harling for their enjoyment and recreation, deserves to be re-told. It is a story of shock and disbelief, bereavement, hope --and above all, true community spirit.

But first we must tell the tragic story of one of the Harling Men remembered on our village war memorial cross Charles Wilkinson Hall, whose circumstances probably first inspired the idea of creating a "Memorial Recreation Ground" in 1946. John and Louisa Hall lived in River View, East Harling and were local farmers and landowners, which included a nine acre field opposite the Church. Mr and Mrs Hall had three sons John, Henry and Charles. Charles was married to a young lady named Irene and during the war served in the Royal Navy as a telegraph operator on board HMS CURACAO, a light cruiser operating in the Atlantic as an escort to troopship convoys approaching home waters. On 2<sup>nd</sup> October 1942, HMS Curacao was rendezvousing with a large liner 40 miles off the north coast of Ireland that was bringing 15,000 American troops to Britain to join the Allied forces. Both the large liner and HMS Curacao were following the usual high-speed zig-zagging procedures to avoid U boats when the huge liner hit the Curacao amidships at right angles, slicing her in half. HMS

Curacao sank within 5 minutes. Of the 439 crew, 338 were drowned, one of whom was Charles Hall. The name of the troopship-liner was The Queen Mary!

All troopships were under strict orders not to stop for survivors under any circumstances '---even if people in the water were waving--'. The Queen Mary, with only relatively minor damage, continued her journey at reduced speed. The few survivors of the collision were picked up later by other naval ships in the convoy. The horror of this disaster was witnessed by many of the 15,000 American troops leaning over the rails of the Queen Mary looking out for signs of enemy submarines and their shock must have been beyond our imagination, but as nothing compared to the shock felt by the families of the dead and missing when they were informed. By 1942 Charles' father had died so it was his widowed mother and his wife, Irene, that received the dreaded telegrams informing them of the death of son and husband.

Of course, the tragedy of war is greater than the death of one man. The sacrifice made by the other Harling Men killed in world war II were just as tragic to their families and loved ones so when peace returned in 1945 their names were added to those already inscribed upon Harling's memorial cross. The village now reflected upon how else they could remember the Harling Men killed in the war, something other than the existing memorial cross, something that would reflect 'life' and 'optimism' for future generations, and so the idea of purchasing a plot of land as a "Memorial Recreation Field" was born.

The whole village rallied around to hold fund raising events and soon their plans became a reality. Louisa Hall, still in mourning from the tragic loss of her son at sea, died in 1946 and her estate included the nine acre field opposite the Church. This field was then conveyed to the village by her two surviving sons and in 1948 the nine acre field was dedicated and officially opened as ----The Harling Memorial Recreation Field. ### Earlier history of the Recreation Ground site, The 9 acre Field

The River Thet abuts the north west corner of the memorial recreation ground and just beyond the bowling green, close to the bridge, the river becomes wide and shallow. Children of the village will tell you that it's where they go fishing for tiddlers or where dogs scamper down to drink and play--but in ancient times this was the Ford, the main crossing point of the river on the ancient road into the village. No one knows exactly how old it is but the ford was certainly there a long time before the bridge. The nine acre field would certainly have some tales to tell of the untold generations of people and livestock that flattened the farmer's crop as they took a short cut between the ford and the market.

If you stood outside the church during the mid 1700's and looked across the road to the large open nine acre field you would have seen a narrow lane, just beyond where the row of cottages now stand, which led to a small enclosed area within that field and upon which stood a WINDMILL. It stood on the highest point of the field on what is now the football pitch, to take advantage of the westerly winds which still blow unhindered from the open fields across the river.

The Windmill is clearly marked on the late 18<sup>th</sup> century Faden's map and also on the 1804 enclosures map but is gone by 1845 when the Harling tithe map was drawn. No doubt future research and the study of land taxes and deeds will reveal the exact date it was erected—and the date it fell---to creak and turn no more.
