

WOMEN'S WORLD DAY OF PRAYER

"I know the plans I have for you"

2022 is a special year for World Day of Prayer in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. This year, we have prepared the World Day of Prayer service. It has been both challenging and rewarding to write about the three countries that make up our area: our landscape, people and culture all shaped by history. We celebrate our diversity and the contribution made to our countries by the many groups and individuals who have their homes here. We use our Bible text "I know the plans I have for you" from Jeremiah to reflect on some of the issues facing us today: poverty, domestic abuse and disability, finding hope in difficult situations and encouragement in the help we can give to each other.

World Day of Prayer is an international ecumenical organisation which enables women all over the world to share the ideas and concerns of the writing country. Preparation for the day has taken several years. Our International Committee based in New York coordinates the work of National Committees and facilitates the creation of our annual World Day of Prayer service on the first Friday in March. The service outline, created by the writing country, is distributed to the rest of the world, along with Bible reflection, country background and activities.

All this work will come to fruition on Friday 4 March 2022 when services will take place beginning in Samoa and moving on through New Zealand and Australia, across Asia, Africa and Europe and finally the United States and South America before finishing in American Samoa. Across England, Wales and Northern Ireland services will take place in large urban centres, such as Central Hall Westminster, and in remote village churches across the three countries.

St Peter & St Paul's Church East Harling service will be held at 6pm on Friday 4th March2022

Dear Friends

As I am writing this, it is about two and a half months since I came to East Harling, and it has genuinely been wonderful so far! However, in coming to the village, and being in such a rural situation, and having eight parishes to look after, I knew that I would need some help with thinking about the role and the new context, and so I asked the Diocese if I could have someone wiser and with more experience to give me some help just reflecting on all of that.

I met with this gentleman yesterday for the first time, and it was a very interesting conversation, challenging but inspiring in equal measure. He asked me what I thought my role was, so I shared my thoughts, and what he suggested in reply was that prayer is the primary job of a priest, before any other thing. Clergy have to do all sorts of things, some which they are good at, and many which, frankly, they're no good at whatsoever! But the one essential, and the absolute primary, role is prayer.

This isn't vague, airy-fairy prayer. It is praying for you. I pray in all sorts of ways, at all sorts of times and in all sorts of places. I help others to pray as well. But my role, which I feel renewed in after yesterday's conversation, is praying for you. So here is what I want to offer to you:

- every single day of my time here, I will be praying for the people, communities, events etc.
 of East Harling, Bridgham, Brettenham, Wretham, Larling, Garboldisham, Blo' Norton and
 Riddlesworth and doing this in some detail. This will take more of my time than I've been
 dedicating up until now, but I think that I agree that it is my main role! So do know that I am
 praying for you every day.
- as I encounter situations e.g. baptisms, weddings and funerals, experiences of need, and so on, I will be praying specifically for those situations.
- if any one of you ever wants me to pray specifically about something please contact me at 01953 558763 or come to the Rectory. I would be genuinely honoured to have the opportunity to pray with and for you.
- if any of you wants to know more about prayer, what it is, how to do it etc. get in touch with me as above. I would be only too delighted to help in any way I can.

I believe that God hears our prayer. Sometimes we see clear evidence of things changing as a result. Sometimes we experience our own lives changing as a result. Sometimes, in all honesty, we pray and pray and pray, and wonder if it will make any difference at all. Woven through all of this experience, over days and weeks, months and years, as I have prayed, I have come to know deep in my being, in my flesh and my bones, as well as my soul, that God walks alongside me, and that this long, ongoing dialogue between us has changed my world, and has changed the world around me. Some of my prayers I'm still waiting on ... but I know by faith that those prayers continue to rest in God's hands.

So please remember, in all things good or bad - there is at least one person who is praying for you! That you can always pray - and if you're not sure how, help is always available. And if you wish to have the prayers of your priest (or any other person you know who prays) - just ask them, for it will be the greatest privilege to say yes.



THE GARDEN IN FEBRUARY



Random February events:

1st -New moon

1st -Chinese New Year (Tiger)

14th - St Valentine's Day

Full moon

Snowdrops and winter aconites

If you are lucky enough to have clumps of these split them when they finish flowering and replant to establish new clumps. If not this is a good time to plant them "in the green" - far more successful than planting dry bulbs in the autumn.

Lawns: A good month to lay turf so that it has time to root down and establish ready for the summer. (Wait until early April to sow seed when the combination of a little warmth and rain will encourage strong growth).

Shrubs, trees and deciduous hedges. Bare root plants are still available at a fraction of the cost of potted ones, and will establish quickly as the soil warms up.

Hedges: Cut deciduous hedges hard to promote new growth before birds start building

Pruning: Prune bush roses hard to outward facing buds.

Perennials: Remove dead material before new shoots begin to grow. Split established plants. Plant new perennials. Tip small plants from garden centres establish quicker than larger ones and in a couple of years will be as big as and healthier than large, more expensive ones.

Tip2 Look around the village - there are several stalls with people selling surplus plants at a fraction of the garden centre prices.

Dahlias: Tubers are now available in the garden centres. Unless you want a particular variety that is the best place for them until next month. If you do buy them protect them from frost but don't store in a dry centrally heated room.

Gladioli: as dahlias.

Sweet Peas: Sow in pots in a cold greenhouse or cold frame. Soak seed overnight (no longer!) before sowing.

Annuals: not until next month

Vegetables: Tip most packets of seeds contain far more than you need. If kept cool and dry, and resealed most seeds will remain viable for several years (not parsnips).

Sow in a heated propagator greenhouse cucumbers and wrinkled peas.

Sow under glass without heat: broad beans, brussels sprouts, cabbage, radishes and salad onions.

Sow outdoors (when ground is not frozen or parsnips, round seeded peas waterlogged): and summer spinach.

Plant early potatoes.

Harvest whatever is ready - remember when the weather warms up many of the overwintered crops like kale and leeks will flower and become only good as compost.

Trays, Pots and Tubs: Plastic pots and tubs and trays cause environmental problems when disposed of, and there are now more environmentally friendly alternatives coming onto the market. However if you have plastic pots you can reduce your environmental impact by washing and re-using them. Toilet roll middles and newspaper rolled into tubes can be stood in a tray and used for sowing individual seeds such as peas and sweet peas, then when you plant out plant the whole container (below soil level or it will act as a wick and dry out the area around the roots)



SAINT VALENTINE - WHO WAS HE?



St. Valentine, (died 3rd century, Rome; feast day February 14), name of one or two legendary

Christian martyrs whose lives seem to be historically based. Although the Roman Catholic Church continues to recognize St. Valentine as a saint of the church, he was removed from the General Roman Calendar in 1969 because of the lack of reliable information about him. He is the patron saint of lovers, epileptics, and beekeepers.

By some accounts, St. Valentine was a Roman priest and physician who suffered martyrdom during the persecution of Christians by the emperor Claudius II Gothicus about 270. He was buried on the Via Flaminia, and Pope Julius I reportedly built a basilica over his grave. Other narratives identify him as the bishop of Terni, Italy, who was martyred, apparently also in Rome, and whose relics were later taken to Terni. It is possible these are different versions of the same original account and refer to only one person.



According to legend, St. Valentine signed a letter "from your Valentine" to his iailer's daughter. whom he had befriended and from healed blindness. Another common leaend states that he defied the emperor's orders and secretly

married couples to spare the husbands from war. Valentine's Day as a lovers' festival dates at least from the 14th century. See Valentine's day recipe for Lemon Biscuits on page 20.

RSPB REPORT ON THE RECENT OUTBREAK OF AVIAN FLU

Avian Flu, or bird flu, is an infectious disease which spreads from bird to bird through contact with infected saliva and droppings. There have been a number of outbreaks of Avian Flu in the UK in recent years, but the vast majority have been in domestic poultry farms.

This current outbreak at RSPB Mersehead is unprecedented - the largest ever in the UK, with more than 4,000 birds having died already. The majority are barnacle geese on the Solway Firth. These geese, which migrate from Svalbard in arctic Norway, have been seen falling from the sky in distress and lines of dead birds have washed up on beaches.

The deaths of the barnacle geese are estimated to be 10% of the total global population. Although most of the cases have been barnacle geese, other species have been affected and there are concerns the disease could spread.

To help prevent the spread of the disease into the wild small garden bird population, good hygiene is key. Cleaning bird feeders and feeding stations weekly, and changing bird drinking and bathing water regularly can make a big difference.

Cleaning out feeders at least every few weeks, but ideally once a week if possible. It does not take very long and we recommend using an animal safe disinfectant. You can use a weak solution of domestic bleach as an alternative. Also, clean out the bird bath if you have one, and clean any space where birds congregate, this will help them to stay healthy. If you can also provide them with clean water every day particularly in icy or very hot weather.

Don't overfill feeders – try and make sure they are being emptied every few days and If possible, set up several different feeding stations to reduce the number of birds in one place. Move your feeders, to prevent the build up of bird food and droppings potentially contaminating the ground below.

Avoid putting feeders under where birds roost, such as under trees, to avoid droppings. If possible clean away any old food or droppings from beneath feeders too.

If you find dead wild waterfowl (swans, geese or ducks) or other dead wild birds, such as gulls or birds of prey, you should report them to the Defra helpline (03459 33 55 77). Do not touch or pick up any dead or visibly sick birds that you find.

A Parade of 200 silk flags mark The Queen's Platinum Jubilee

River of Hope is an arts-based learning project linking schools around the world through the study of rivers. In 2022, River of Hope forms a central part of The Queen's Platinum Jubilee celebrations. The Queen has always shown a great love and respect for the natural environment. It is hoped that this project will encourage young people around the world to think about the importance of safeguarding the future of their own natural environment. The focus for designs is "Hope for the future" with a spotlight on the environment and protecting the planet.

Interested schools receive packs which encourage the use of art to teach environmental themes. The packs provided take teachers through a step-by-step guide to creating an imaginative piece of artwork, with their students, using art and design skills and utilising either natural or recycled materials, while encouraging young people to think about their hopes and aspirations for the next 70 years. Two hundred of the artworks created will be printed onto silk flags and will be processed as part of The Queen's Platinum Jubilee Pageant. In addition, there will be an online gallery on the below website to display all the artworks entered from around the world.

It is intended that these 200 silk flags will then be carried together to produce a river effect, flowing through the streets of central London and paraded along the Mall as a 'River of Hope' as the Platinum Pageant comes to a close outside Buckingham Palace. The winning designs will also be digitised to be shown on big screens around the UK as part of the Jubilee celebrations. They will be a focal point of the Pageant which will see thousands of performers tell the story of The Queen's reign through art, music and theatre. The celebrations will involve people from across the UK and the Commonwealth.





Valentine's Day Lemon Biscuits



Ingredients

200g soft butter 140g caster sugar 1 egg yolk 1 tsp vanilla extract Zest 2 lemons, juice 1

280g plain flour, plus a little

extra for rolling ½ jar good lemon curd 140g icing sugar sifted

Method

Stir together the butter, sugar, egg yolk, vanilla and zest from 1 lemon using a wooden spoon. Stir in the flour – you might need to get your hands in at the end. Tip onto a floured surface, bring together into a smooth dough, then roll out, half at a time, and stamp out 5-8cm rounds. Keep re-rolling trimmings, you should get about 40 biscuits. Arrange on trays lined with baking parchment, cover with cling film and chill for 30 mins.

Heat oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6. Bake the biscuits for 8-12 mins until pale golden, then cool. Once cool, spread half the biscuits with a little lemon curd and top with a second biscuit. Arrange the biscuits on wire racks over trays. Mix enough lemon juice into the icing sugar to give a runny consistency, then drizzle over the biscuits. Scatter over a bit more lemon zest and leave to set.
