When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you.

(Isaiah 43.2)

Dear friends,

As I write this, we have been plunged back into the mire of fear and uncertainty, following the news of the omicron variant of COVID-19 - and by the time you read this, who knows what will have happened, or will be about to happen.

Like everyone, I feel my own share of anxiety, frustration and irritation at this point ... I think we all thought that by this time, things would be starting, if not to go back to normal, at least to be finding their way to some new, more stable state of affairs. But I fear that the uncertainty and instability we've had for nearly two years now may be set to continue for longer than any of us thought.

So what is a good response? It is certainly not good to deny the reality of what is happening - either to try to pretend it's not happening at all, or to refuse to be part of the collective effort to protect each other, and ourselves. But neither is it good to cut ourselves off, to continue to isolate in the way we did initially. If we've learnt anything, it's that we really do need each other! Family, friends, neighbours, community ... and if nothing else, I hope that each of you now sees the value of the people in your life, and will not forget that as things - eventually - do settle down.

As I consider my attitude and behaviours going forward, for me as a Christian, I have always found the verse at the beginning of this message hugely helpful. When I read the Bible, I do not see messages telling me that faith will make everything ok. There is no indication that God promises to, as it were, airlift us to safety, if we can just believe strongly enough. But the promise that is there, over and over again, is that when we go through trouble, we don't do it alone. Sometimes life feels like wading through floods, and sometimes it really does feel like walking through fire - and I have had my fair share of those times of frustration, or pain, or grief and so on.

But I believe, and have experienced myself, that when I am happy, God is with me; when I am sad, God is with me; when I am in pain, God is with me; and when I feel fear, God is with me. And so I can step forward, trying my best to be fully human - sent out to live, and to love, to work and to rest, but in the knowledge that I am never alone.

As we move into 2022, I pray that each and every one of you will realise that whatever challenges you may meet, you are not alone. I pray that your communities will strengthen and sustain you, and bring you joy. And I pray that you will come to know how much you are loved, by the Love that set all things in motion.

### THE GARDEN IN JANUARY

Of winters lifeless world each tree Now seems a perfect part Yet each one holds a summer secret Deep down within its heart (Charles G Slater)



More than most months January gardening is very weather determined. Over recent years long very cold spells have become less common, while prolonged wet periods are becoming the norm. Walking on the soil when it is waterlogged can cause excessive compaction which makes it harder for air and water to get through the top layer (look at the affect the pigs have on Lopham Road and by the fiveways junction stopping the rain from soaking in and causing excessive run-off and loss of soil from the fields).

If the soil is reasonably dry and frost free there are many jobs that can usefully be carried out this month, and gardening is a good form of exercise. Don't turn over the soil when there is ice or snow - soil is a good insulator and it will take longer to warm up in the Spring.

Shrubs and young trees - After the strong winds of the autumn these may have rocked about, and need the soil firming around them, and possibly staking. It is a good time to tidy up and remove dead and damaged wood.

Deciduous hedges can be cut hard to encourage new growth before the birds start nesting towards the end of February.

Dahlias - If you dug and stored your dahlia tubers these should be checked and treated with a fungicide if needed. Bulbs - Bring last pots of Hyacinths and other bulbs indoors to force early flowering - don't subject to excessive heat or over water or they will stretch and become leggy. Put pots that have finished flowering in a cold frame or cold greenhouse for a couple of weeks to acclimatise before planting out.

Potatoes.- If you have space in a cool room to spread out some seed potatoes, they have been in the garden centres since before Christmas (far too early!) it is worth buying a

few to have a better choice of varieties. Cardboard egg boxes/ trays are ideal for spreading them out. Don't leave them in their plastic bags, and certainly not in the dark. First and second earlies don't need chitting (leaving in warm light position until short sturdy shoots appear). Planting under fleece in a cold greenhouse late in February, or if you want to plant them outdoors leave until mid-March onwards.

Fruit Trees- Continue winter pruning (not cherries, apricots, peaches or plums which are subject to fungal diseases if open wounds are left).

Vegetables - Finish digging the veg plot as soon as possible. Towards the middle of the month put cloches or fleece over the area where you sow in February (parsnips, peas and spinach).

Sow early cauliflowers in a heated propagator or windowsill. Sow under cold glass broad beans, lettuces, leeks and onions. Continue to harvest broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbages, kale, leeks and parsnips.

Wildlife – Please keep your birdbaths topped up with fresh water and keep free from ice. If you haven't already done so clean out bird boxes ready for the coming season - do this in the middle of the day because birds may be using them to roost at his time of year.

### EAST HARLING PRIMARY SCHOOL AND NURSERY.

FROM THE GOVERNING BODY



2021 was possibly the most challenging in the school's history, with the school starting the year closed to all but key worker and vulnerable children. Teaching staff were alternating days in school and then at home in order provide remote learning provision. Focus was very much on the wellbeing of staff and safeguarding of pupils, especially those deemed to be vulnerable.

During the next couple of months the school worked hard to provide remote learning to its pupils, and drew on the experience of the previous year's lockdown to help deliver this provision.

With the return to school in March, pupils were on the whole pleased to be back and seeing their friends again. Teaching



of the curriculum continued as planned, alongside catch-up learning provision, but with a focus on core skills and helping the children build up independence and resilience. A big

emphasis was made on the emotional wellbeing of pupils during this time, as this reflected on their ability to learn. This is where the nurturing ethos of the school came to the fore.

The summer term saw classes continue to be taught in bubbles, with teaching staff continuing to assess pupil's progress. Interaction between each year group was very limited, and whole school activities like assemblies continued to be provided virtually. The lack of interaction afforded by both pupils and staff during this time, and its associated pressures cannot be underestimated, and it is again testament to the resilience of its pupils and hard work and commitment of its staff and leadership team that the good ship East Harling got through it.

Sadly, after 21 years working at the school, Jane Kelly retired at the end of the Summer term. Her contribution to the school was immense and we wished her well in her future endeavours.

The return to school in September saw a new academic year where class bubbles were removed but restrictions were still in place. The prevalence of Covid in the wider community has inevitably seen cases in the school, with some staff and pupils being affected. The effect this had and continues to have on the day to day running of the school is again another massive challenge. Unfortunately this is a challenge that the whole school community will continually have to meet for the foreseeable future.

In October the school were visited by Ofsted for its latest inspection, the outcome of which was that East Harling remains a GOOD school. Safeguarding and special needs provision were deemed to be strong and effective.

The Governing Body welcomed two new Parent Governors in December and this January onwards, among other things, will focus on the school's delivery of the curriculum and pupil progress + attainment. We also plan to improve our visibility and engagement with the greater school community.

We as a Governing Body are immensely proud to serve our school and again take his opportunity to thank all members of staff and leadership team for their efforts in 2021.

Also thanks to all parents / carers for your unerring support of the school at this difficult time.

### TALES OF OLD HARLING -14. David Bailey.

#### "Operation Harling" in World War II.

1942 was an especially hard year in the Allied fight against the tyranny of Nazi Germany. Japan had recently joined the conflict and the war was escalating beyond all expectations. 1942 was also an especially tough year for many Norfolk families, their menfolk in the Norfolk Regiment had recently all been taken prisoner by the Japanese when Singapore fell in February. In North Africa many were feared captured as the Germans stormed the allied stronghold of Tobruk . Field Marshal Rommel, 'The Desert Fox', seemed unstoppable! Moral was on a knife-edge. How to stop Rommel capturing Libya and Egypt and gaining almost total control of the Mediterranean became an urgent priority. It is at this point that Harling enters the story-well, by the use of its name anyway.

### OPERATION HARLING

Harling gave its name to one of the most important acts of sabotage carried out by a British force during World War II. Its code name was "Operation Harling" and was successfully carried out on 25<sup>th</sup> November 1942.

The objective of Operation Harling was to sabotage an important railway viaduct that spanned the Gorgopotamatos Gorge in northern Greece to stem the flow of arms and supplies from Germany to supply Field Marshal Edwin Rommel's Afrika Korps. Nearly fifty supply trains a day crossed the Gorgopotamatos Gorge, a vulnerable weak link in the rail system of Greece, its destruction would cause maximum disruption to Rommel's plans, gain time for The Allies and save many lives.

BUT -why was it called "Operation Harling"? I have tried to find out if there was any connection with our village. Whether, perhaps, a man or woman from Harling was in a seat of military power in Whitehall and thus authorised to decide the code-names of wartime military operations?

Perhaps someone simply got a pin, stuck it in a map and located our bus stop on the market place, proclaiming "--it shall be called HARLING"? We will never know of course, as it was and presumably still is, top secret stuff. I have enquired with a contact who knows about such things if he knew how names of wartime "operations" are chosen. He believes that there

is (was) a secret book of official operation code names in alphabetical order and once a name is chosen it can never be re-used for any other military operation. This makes sense -----but who chose "Harling" and why? Whatever the reason, it is surely an honour to know that the name of our village is associated with an amazing act of bravery that helped the allied troops to eventually win the struggle in the North Africa Campaign— some of whom could well have been 'Harling Men'.

After its successful outcome in November 1942, Operation Harling was described as "--- having a great effect on Rommel's supplies----cutting six valuable weeks of supplies to the Afrika Korps—depriving them of 2,000 train-loads of supplies".

Operation Harling was also welcomed as "--outstanding to the struggle in North Africa---led
by British Officers with the indispensable
assistance of Greek Guerrillas".


