

Dear friends

The morning that I write this, I was in one of the schools with which I am blessed to be involved, taking an assembly. The theme for this half term is 'Wisdom' ... a wonderful subject, but one that is quite tricky when trying to think of something helpful and interesting for 5-11 year old children!

In the end, I went to the beginning and said that wisdom starts with listening ... we discussed that for a little bit, but we ended by sitting and listening together. Not listening to anyone speak, or music or anything like that. Just listening to the space and the quietness around us (which, when you start to actually listen, you realise is anything but silent). Also listening to what is happening in our minds, our hearts, our bodies. We only did it for a few moments, but it felt like a beautiful way to start the school week, and the children were all able to do that thing of being still and listening, for a short time at least!

From a Christian point of view, I think that this is a good practice for us all – Psalm 46.10 says 'Be still and know that I am God.' Being still, listening, waiting, just breathing ... all of this (which basically adds up to the practice that we call contemplation) brings us into the awareness that God is with us, that we are utterly immersed in God's love, much as a fish's whole life is spent immersed in water. The fish swims around, and lives its life, but is surrounded and held by the water. So you and I do our work, and have our rest, and engage in all the thousand other things of daily life – but we are constantly held in God's love. Stopping, listening, waiting, breathing ... all these give us the chance to realise that this is the case.

And even if you are not of a religious persuasion – why not take time to do the same? To just stop, listen, wait, breathe. The worst that will happen is that you will have a few moments to just relax, to be at one with yourself and your world. Beyond that ... who knows what (or Who) you might encounter?

JUNE IN THE GARDEN



Flaming June??? - you never know!

Well in spite of being unbelievably dry in April mother nature has done her thing and with 2 weeks

to go in May everything in the garden is doing what it should, more or less on time.

Tasks for June:

Wild flower garden: At the time of writing (early May) I counted 14 different "weeds" in flower on the early morning dog walk up Lopham Road. Enjoy Mother Nature's garden while you are out and about. Already, though, the grass, nettles and brambles are beginning to choke them out. If you have set aside an area for wild flowers the same will happen unless you intervene. If anything is getting out of hand trim, thin or remove. Don't mow before late July, and always remove any plant waste from the site to reduce the fertility of the site - wild flowers do not need rich soil whereas most of their competitors do.

Lawns: Mow weekly when dry. If you have room try to leave a corner for nature (see above)

Fuchsias: Take cuttings from new growth early in the month. Remember to label - most of them look very similar until they flower.

Roses: remove any suckers as near to the base as possible. Cut out any dead sections. Dead head to encourage more flowers

Perennials: Cut down early flowering varieties when the flowers finish to about 3 inches above the ground. Dead head lupins and other perennials as soon as the flowers are over and with a bit of luck you may get a second flowering in late summer.

Greenhouse: Apply shading to prevent scorching. A small box of shading powder when mixed with water will cover an 8ft x 12ft greenhouse. Finish pricking out seedlings. Plant tomatoes, peppers and cucumbers either in the ground or large pots in the greenhouse.

Remember to keep watered - the sun can be hot at this time of year. Keep well ventilated.

Pots and tubs: Keep well-watered remember the 7inch (17cm) rule. An inch (2.5cm) of water will soak down 7inches (17cm) of compost. Feed flowers with a high potassium plant food weekly. Remember it rarely puts an inch of rain down, so even if we have a wet June the containers will still need watering, and if they are against a wall there will be a rain shadow (an area where little or no rain falls due to the overhang of the eaves.)

Bulbs: divide and replant daffodils, narcissi and bluebells.

Fruit: Cover with netting unless you are growing for the birds! Particularly red currants and cherries. Pick red and black currants and gooseberries when they are ready. Continue pulling rhubarb and remove any flower stems before they set seed (flowering saps the strength from the crown and weakens the plant for next year).

Vegetables: a busy month. Remember the separate flower and vegetable plots is a Victorian invention - if you only have a small space there is no reason why you shouldn't mix veg in with your flowers, or most can be grown in pots.

Sow outdoors: French and runner beans, beetroot, carrots, lettuce, peas, radishes (a few at fortnightly intervals), spinach and swedes.

Plant out Broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbages cauliflowers (not fantastic in the dry Brecks soil), leeks and tomatoes.

Harvest: asparagus (until the middle of the month, then leave to build up the plant for next year), late sprouting broccoli, broad beans, spring and summer cabbages, radishes anything else that is ready.

General: If you haven't already, clean off the barbeque - with a bit of luck the weather will be kind and last year's restrictions are no more!

The newly arrived visiting house martins, having travelled miles to return to their original nesting sites, need to have the puddles to be able to collect the mud for the building of their little nests on the sides of our houses and buildings. The wildflowers and meadows need to have moisture to grow and hopefully enable us to enjoy a mixture of colour, a variety of flowers and weeds, some native to the Breckland area and others like the common cuchweed, which is critically endanger in Europe is we are delighted to find growing in the church path for all to enjoy when visiting.

The newly drilled sugar beet seeds can seen gradually coming through the land, they need to have moisture to be able to grow on and of course in the longer term be able to produce sugar for all of us to use in the future once it has been processed. The cereal crops need to grow on for us to have a successful corn harvest and the straw which will be needed for the bedding of the livestock or for use at the local power plant will ideally have to be longer before the combines are rolling once again as the 2022 harvest gets underway.

Rev Simon sent us a prayer for rain a couple of weeks ago and although we have been recalling the words, we still need to see much more falling from the skies. I realise that a little is better than none and we are grateful for what we have had but the main rain across the country seems to have been either in the West or further up North, come East is what we need.!! During the dark hours would be better for the holiday makers etc.!! but please just rain.

In the meantime, let us hope for safe days ahead, especially when we think of those trying to cope with all the tragic events across the lands. We hope that you will enjoy celebrating the platinum jubilee in a variety of different ways (let's hope it doesn't rain on the event days!) and of course if you wish to join us for a service on the fourth Sunday of each month at 11.00am you would be more than welcome.
