



Bishop's Green Badge

Here's how to get a Bishop's Green Badge.

Step 1: Download the PDF for the correct age group from the website and have a look at the ideas of things to do. Each one contains several options to get you started, but you're very welcome to be creative and come up with your own ideas instead!

Step 2: Over the summer holidays, do something to care for the environment. To get a Bishop's Green Badge each child/young person only needs to do one thing. But, of course, you can do more than one. Why not see how many things you can do before going back to school?!

Step 3: Fill in the simple application form with the name, age and address of each child/young person, and one sentence for each telling us what they have done to earn the Bishop's Green Badge.
Please return this to us by Monday 5th September.

Step 4: Wait for the badge and certificate to drop through your letter box!

Step 5: We would love it if you could give us some feedback once the pilot has finished. We'll send you details of how to do this once we have received your application.
