We are also invaluablely supported by a team of volunteers (and are always happy to meet others interested in joining the team). Although the inpatient unit is at the Cavell Centre, on the main PCH site, the vast majority of mental health treatment takes place in the community these days, so we spend a lot of our time out and about, as well as meeting people online or speaking to them by phone. Our work is designed to build community with people who experience mental health challenges (an increasing proportion of the population) and to practice compassion by simply “being human together”. We do this through various groups, both online and in person, and through 1:1 support. We support people of all faiths and none, recognising that all human beings have spiritual needs and some of these are expressed through religion. Our
