

### **JOHN DANIELL – LEAD OFSTED INSPECTOR**

John Daniell has worked in four schools for 26 years, including 14 years as a senior leader. John joined Ofsted as one of Her Majesty's Inspectors in 2010. He worked in the East of England and London regions and led several types of inspections including of primary schools, secondary schools, sixth forms and independent schools. John also reviewed the effectiveness of two multi-academy trusts and of a local authority's school improvement service. John's specialism is modern foreign languages and he was Ofsted's National Lead for Modern Foreign Languages until 2018.

John is now Director of his own education consultancy. In addition, he continues to work as a Lead Ofsted Inspector in the East of England and in London. He also quality assures inspection reports for Ofsted and investigates complaints against Ofsted.

John is also contracted by a local authority in the East of England to provide school improvement services. These include: headteachers' performance management, standards visits, and various reviews including sixth form provision, pupil premium expenditure, safeguarding and governance.

John has a master's degree in educational management and administration, as well as the National Professional Qualification for Headship.

### **YVONNE WATTS – LEAD OFSTED INSPECTOR**

Dr Yvonne Watts has 14 years' experience as a primary headteacher in Northamptonshire church schools. Her first school gained outstanding status under her leadership, which was sustained until she moved on to a new challenge in a larger and more diverse school. During her headships, Yvonne took on two short-term executive headteacher positions, one of which helped support a junior school out of special measures and the other to cover a maternity leave. Yvonne set up her own education consultancy in 2017, and now supports a number of schools and multi-academy trusts with their school improvement, alongside working with two education charities.

Yvonne was a Local Leader of Education, which involved working with schools and their leadership teams to help improve the teaching and learning or other aspects of school improvement. Alongside headship, from 2007 to 2018, Yvonne was also a Lead and Team Ofsted Inspector. She has led both Section 5 and Section 8 inspections, although has now decided to focus solely on school improvement work.

Whilst a serving head, Yvonne undertook a master's degree in education, its focus being on school leadership and management. This was followed by over five years of study working towards the Doctorate in Education. Yvonne's thesis was published in 2012, with her study focusing on the implications for primary headteachers in the Ofsted process.
