World Diabetes Day - Access to
diabetes care.

Globally, an estimated 422 million adults were living with diabetes in 2014, compared to 108 million in 1980.

The global prevalence of diabetes has nearly doubled since 1980, rising from 4.7% to 8.5% in the adult population. This reflects an increase in associated risk factors such as being overweight or obese. Over the past decade, diabetes prevalence has risen faster in low and middle-income countries than in high-income countries.

Diabetes is a major cause of blindness, kidney failure, heart attack, stroke and lower limb amputation.

Healthy diet, physical activity and avoiding tobacco use can prevent or delay type 2 diabetes. In addition diabetes can be treated and its consequences avoided or delayed with medication, regular screening and treatment for complications.

100 years after the discovery of insulin, millions of people with diabetes around the world cannot access the care they need. People with diabetes require ongoing care and support to manage their condition and avoid complications.

Holy Spirit, please help us to be bolder about praying for healing. Help those in need of healing to trust in You with all of their hearts and not depend on their own understanding. Loving Father, please open the eyes of anyone with diabetes and broaden their understanding of their illness, help them to make healthy choices to defeat the symptoms of diabetes. Remind them to look to You for help, strength and power. Bless them to find others who will help support them along the way to ensure they are making better life choices. We ask for this through Jesus Christ our Saviour and Redeemer. Amen

20 November World Children's Day

World Children's Day offers each of us an inspirational entry-point to advocate, promote and celebrate children's rights, translating into dialogues and actions that will build a better world for children.

But Jesus called them to him, saying, "Let the children come to me, and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God." Luke 18:16


